PIGGY BANK PAGEANT 2022 RULES

1. ENTRIES:

- a. This Competition is open to students enrolled in Kindergarten to Grade 6 in the Territory of the Virgin Islands.
- b. Only one First Prize, Second Prize, and Third Prize winner will be announced in **EACH** of the following three (4) categories:
 - i. CATEGORY ONE Kindergarten (or equivalent grade);
 - ii. CATEGORY TWO Grade 1 and Grade 2 (or equivalent grade);
 - iii. CATEGORY THREE Grade 3 and Grade 4 (or equivalent grade);
 - iv. CATEGORY FOUR Grade 5 and Grade 6 (or equivalent grade).
- c. Limit One entry per child.

2. THE PIGGY BANK:

a. This year, children will have the option of creating their own piggy bank from plastic materials, OR decorating and accessorizing a basic MONEY MATTERS BVI bank.

b. ORIGINAL BANK

- The main container used for the Bank here must have been recycled, and be a material i.e. plastic, cardboard, etc., which is safe for handling by children; glass is not acceptable.
- ii. Maximum Bank size 12" x 12" x 12".
- iii. The Bank must have a place where money can be inserted, must be sturdy enough to hold money, and to be transported without falling apart.

c. ACCESSORISED BANK

- i. Children who select this option will have a starter structure to create their Bank.
- ii. Children should get creative, using foam, feathers, straws, pipe cleaners, plastics, shells, paper, rocks, fabric, and or any other safe crafty materials of choice to decorate and accessorize their Bank.
- iii. When finished accessorizing, the maximum Bank size should be 12"x 12"x 12".
- iv. The finished Bank must leave access for money to be inserted.
- d. Adults may provide supervisory assistance to the children, but the Bank must be the work of the child.

3. SUBMISSIONS:

- a. Entrants MUST submit three (3) photos to <u>finlit@bvifsc.vg</u> by midnight on the <u>Deadline</u>
 1st March 2023;
 - i. PHOTO 1 to show the main "unaltered" recycled material or basic bank used to create the Bank;
 - ii. PHOTO 2 to show the child in production process (both child and Bank in photo);

iii. PHOTO 3 – to show the best angle of the completed Piggy Bank (both child and Bank in photo).

IMPORTANT NOTE: The child's full name and school name should be visible as part of photo 3.

4. JUDGING:

- a. Scoring Rubric will be out of 100 with each of the following having the potential to garner 10 points: Adherence to deadline, dimensions, materials, money slot requirement, photo submission requirements, creativity requirement, sturdiness/balance, functionality, visual appeal, neatness of work.
- b. One Judge from each participating Bank will review submissions and select winners. Any ties will be broken by the President of the BVI Bank Association.
- c. Winners will be announced on the MMBVI Facebook page during Financial Literacy Month April 2022.

5. OTHER

- a. Voucher usage will be subject to the issuing bank's requirements.
- b. MONEY MATTERS BVI reserves the right to use any submission in the future, to promote saving/banking among children.
